The Community Association for Riders with Disabilities (CARD) is a non-profit organization whose mission is “to improve the lives of children and adults with disabilities, through quality therapeutic riding programs”.

Founded in 1969, CARD was the very first therapeutic riding facility in Canada!

Each year, CARD helps over 100 children and adults each term live independent lives by improving coordination, muscle strength, balance, communication and motor skills, and by helping to develop greater confidence and self-esteem. Through a consistent assessment process, and one on one therapy, CARD riders continue to embrace new life skills, overcome personal obstacles and rise to the challenge of improving the quality of their lives.

At the heart of CARD is its’ herd of amazing therapy horses! These horses are generously donated or purchased by donors and each horse is ADORED by riders, staff and volunteers alike. The reason is because they are incredible, compassionate and caring animals; special and unique in their patience, adaptability and generosity of spirit. Their character(s) help to build trust with CARD’s riders and create a bond that CARD refers to as “*the magical connection*”. It is a bond that is healing and inspiring as the therapy each horse provides is life changing!

Each horse was chose for its movement, size, temperament, compassion and talent. CARD's horses are a great asset and.... The constitute one of the greatest operating expense that CARD has.

While CARD works with suppliers to reduce costs and secure donations wherever possible, Horse Sponsorships and Horse Care donations are some of the most important funds CARD raises. These dollars help keep CARD's operating costs to a minimum and have a direct impact on the cost of the therapeutic riding program. The savings are passed directly on to CARD's riders with disabilities – CARD is able to significantly subsidize the therapeutic riding program and offer it to each rider at just a third of the actual cost.

While the majority of CARD's herd is generously donated by patrons and friends, there are times when CARD must purchase a horse to fill a specific need or gap in the program. The Full Therapy Horse Sponsorship is a special opportunity to participate directly in changing the life of a child or adult with a disability by covering the cost of the purchase of a new horse, or to cover all the costs associated with the maintenance of one therapy horse for one full year.

Black Canadian gelding born in 2002. He stands 16.1 hh.

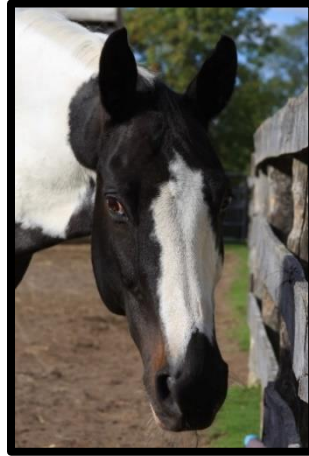

Bay Quarter Horse/Percheron/Thoroughbred Gelding born in 1991. He stands 15.2 hh.

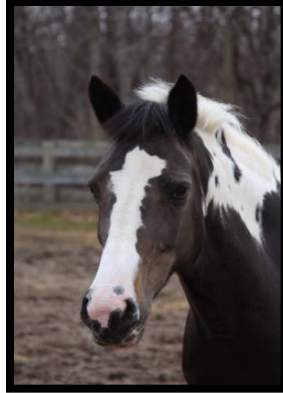
He is currently sponsored by The Baran Family Foundation.
